CIWM (WAMITAB) Level 1 Award in Cleaning Principles

About this qualification

Learners will develop the basic knowledge and skills required by employers within the cleaning industry. This qualification is designed for anyone looking to improve their employment prospects for the future by gaining a greater understanding of cleaning activities. Once learners have achieved this qualification, they will be able to progress directly into entry level job roles within the sector.

- Individuals working in the wider supply-chain of cleaning and facilities management organisations

How is this qualification delivered?

This qualification can be delivered face to face or virtually in a classroom environment and assessed by multiple choice question paper.

What does this qualification cover?

To achieve this qualification, learners must complete the mandatory unit - Introduction to Cleaning Principles. This unit is designed to ensure that individuals will:

- Understand the importance of cleaning
- Know how to identify and categorise soil in preparation for cleaning
- Know how to safely select and use cleaning agents
- Know how to safely select and use cleaning equipment and methods
- Understand how to work safely

What are the entry requirements of this qualification?

This qualification is open entry. This means that learners interested in undertaking the CIWM (WAMITAB) Level 1 Award in Cleaning Principles do not require any other qualifications or levels of attainment to take this qualification.

What job role could this qualification lead to or support?

Learners that achieve the CIWM (WAMITAB) Level 1 Award in Cleaning Principles will be able to progress into employment in the cleaning industry.
